# KIM'S WRITING JOURNEY SPEAKING TOPICS






But even with renewed hope and a devoted faith in this man of God, can Mary and her older sister, Martha, face their biggest challenge... without Jesus?


#### **Shooting Stars Traveling Circus**

Every woman's secret weapon is her little black dress, but for fashion model-turned covert agent Evan Tyler, her weaponized wardrobe makes her absolutely deadly.







Can they expose a killer before becoming the next victim?



# The Innocent Assassin, The Traveling Companion, Book 1

In the final days of World War II, Penny Tompkins has one last mission. She's a British assassin, trained by the Special Operations Executive, and her final target is a notorious SS officer, Yann Kohler. But when Penny wakes aboard a train with the man's lifeless body beside her and the murder weapon planted at her feet, she realizes the hunter has become the hunted.

- I. What inspired you to begin writing mysteries and clean romantic suspense novels? I've always loved mysteries and suspense, but so many of the books I'd start were so full of sexually explicit scenes or vulgar language that I couldn't get through them. I wanted to write novels that matched my faith and values, knowing that other readers felt the same way.
- 2. How do you develop the intricate plots and twists that keep readers on the edge of their seats? I enjoy layering a story (and its characters) with multiple motives and what ifs. When I start developing a plot or a character, I ask myself what secrets are hiding beneath the main story. What kind of history needs to reveal itself as a character grows. What happened in the past that can rear its ugly head at the worst possible time. I think we can all relate to having a secret and the fear that it will come out.
- 3. Can you share your process for creating relatable and compelling characters? I take a lot of inspiration from all the wonderful people I've know in my life. I like to showcase their quirky personalities and strong stubborn attitudes. I want to give them a voice on the page to match their challenges. I show their strengths and their flaws.
- 4. What role does setting play in your novels, and how do you choose the locations for your stories? It's extremely important. My stories all take place in iconic locations—Paris, London, Kyiv, Dallas, even outer space. I try to make sure I describe just enough setting sensory through description, music, food, fashion, and dialog to give the reader an immersive experience.
- 5. Have any real-life events or experiences influenced your writing, and if so, how? I think there's a little piece of me in every story I write. One example was a mission trip I was on in 2014 to Ukraine. Being in such a legendary place as Kyiv and seeing the damage to the beautiful buildings from war (and this is before the current war) gave me such a feeling of overwhelm and empathy, I had to include it in a story—Bare Essentials.
- 6. How do you ensure that your novels maintain a balance between suspense and romance? That can be a challenge, but I think giving the romance equal weight with the main mystery or intrigue—making sure that one drives the other—creates a nice dance within the story.
- 7. What challenges do you face when writing within the mystery and romantic suspense genres? I think I tend to sprinkle too many cookie crumbs too early in my first drafts and it is always a little tougher to camouflage the big clues and move them to a better hiding place as I edit.
- 8. How has your writing evolved over the past 10 years, and what have you learned from your journey? My writing has much more description than it used to, because my readers have consistently asked for a little more. But I still try to keep it tight so that everything is pertinent to the story. Not too much flowery language or excess verbiage. I have an incredible critique group that aren't afraid to tell me what I'm lacking or what I'm overdoing. They are priceless to me.
- 9. Can you describe the feeling of winning awards for your writing and how it has impacted your career? I've won several awards for many of my novels, and I always find it encouraging— like a little boost of confidence that I'm doing what I was meant to do. It has offered me a few opportunities that I perhaps wouldn't have enjoyed otherwise.
- 10. What advice would you give to aspiring authors looking to write in the same genres as you? Read. Read a lot. Read in genre and out. Read writers' craft books as well as novels and short stories and screenplays. Everything you need to know about building a mystery and developing a romance can be found in these if you have the eyes to see and the willingness to learn.

Kim Black serves on the board of directors for the Texas High Plains Writers, one of the oldest writing groups in the US, established as Panhandle Pen Women in 1920. THPW is a non-profit organization dedicated to supporting writers throughout their journey from inspiration to publication. She serves on the committee for the New Frontiers in Writing Conference hosted by THPW. New Frontiers in Writing will launch its inaugural Conference in Amarillo, Texas in 2025.
